The first draft of our Neighbourhood Plan has undergone several amendments and changes with the help of our steering group and I am pleased to say that it is now out for consultation until the end of April. We have already had responses from some of the statutory consultees and we will look at all the responses, amending the plan if appropriate in May before submitting it to CC for final approval. This stage can take several months but once done we will be able to hold a referendum which, if successful, means that the Lanlivery Neighbourhood will be adopted and have a major influence on local planning decisions.
