Cllr Turner highlighted the problem of people not picking up after their dogs, particularly when they were walking them in the Glebe Field, which was technically private property. It was agreed that Cllr Turner would write a letter for inclusion in the Granite Towers explaining the health implications for livestock and encouraging people to pick up when walking their dogs anywhere in the parish.

It was proposed by Cllr Sinkins, seconded Cllr Turner and RESOLVED that the parish council should purchase a defibrillator from the Ronnie Richards Foundation to site in Lanlivery village and that the members of the parish council and the Clerk should be trained in its use. Cllr Sinkins and the Clerk would follow up grant funding applications.
