PA12/02112. Retrospective permission for one mobile home and one garage. Little Tredinnick, Tredinnick Pits. Proposed Cllr Christophers, seconded Cllr Bonney and RESOLVED that a recommendation of objection should be submitted to Cornwall Council. *Reason: The parish council has reported the illegal occupation of this site on many occasions in the past and is, in any event, opposed to the principle of retrospective planning applications. Additionally, this is an application for development in open countryside with no agricultural or any other grounds for approval.*

PA12/02148. Construction of agricultural building with new access to highway. Land adjacent to the A390, Lostwithiel. Proposed Cllr Christophers, seconded Cllr Haley and RESOLVED that a recommendation of support should be submitted to Cornwall Council. *Reason: This is a genuine, local family business seeking to expand*

Gilbert Rawlings enforcement ongoing. Cllrs requested a further update from planning enforcement.

11/129 HM The Queen's Diamond Jubilee

Cllr Haley had obtained 30m of bunting, 6 big Union Jack flags and serviettes. Cllr Christophers was working on the road closure from 1pm until 8pm for the street party. A risk assessment would be required, which she would coordinate.

It was agreed that the tea should be served at 4pm followed by the photograph. The Church would be available in the event of bad weather.

The school would allow the use of electricity for tea urns etc. Cllr Turner would ask if the school would also allow the use of its toilet facilities.

The fund raising Quiz would be held on 8th May

Cllr Hughes reported that the Chapman's would dig out a pit for the beacon and would enclose it with electric fencing. The Chapman's had also confirmed that they held public liability insurance, which would cover the event. The Church would supply hot drinks, soup and a barbecued food for sale.
