Cllr Richards advised that he had been led to believe that Lanhydrock parish council did not wish to take up the offer from Lanhydrock Estate to organise a beacon on Helman Tor. Cllr Hughes was asked to reply to Andrew Williams thanking him very much for his kind offer but explaining that Lanlivery would be lighting its beacon at the usual location in the Chapman's field. Cllrs hoped that Andrew would continue with the Helman Tor beacon but sadly it would be impossible for people to be present at both locations, as the beacons would be lit simultaneously. Food at the event in the Chapman's field would be organised by the PCC.

 ± 150.00 had already been pledged towards the street party; the provisional date was still 5th June, subject to confirmation.

It was agreed that a village photograph should be organised.

Cllr Turner reported that £5.00 Jubilee coins were available and the school was prepared to finance coins for any children living outside the parish if the parish council funded coins for the local youngsters. Cllr Richards suggested that a silk sash might be more affordable. Other suggestions were a silver spoon, an egg cup, a brass plaque, a plate, a medallion.

It was agreed that it would be appropriate to plant a commemorative tree. Flags would be needed for the tables; Cllr Richards and Cllr Haley would follow this up. The Feast bunting would be left up until after the Jubilee celebrations.
