11/35 Public Questions/Police Report

Police report. PC Barnicoat introduced himself as the Neighbourhood Beat Manager for Lanlivery and reported 1 crime (theft of cement mixer) and 2 incident logs generated in June. PCSO Phillips reported that she had been contacted by Mr Patterson of Balquolly House, who was interested in setting up a Neighbourhood Watch Scheme in the parish. Cllrs noted that this had been tried unsuccessfully in the past but thought it might be possible to start such a scheme on a hamlet basis; possibly Lanlivery hamlet could be used to trial such a system.
