### 22/77 Planning

 PA22/05493. Amended Plans. Formation of MUGA (Multi Use Games Area) on existing playing field of Red Moor School. Churchtown Farm, Road from Junction of Pennant and Snow Hill to Junction south of Churchtown Farm, PL30 5BT. It was proposed by Cllr Sinkins, seconded Cllr Paterson and RESOLVED that a recommendation of no objection should be made to Cornwall Council.

### 22/78 Operation London Bridge

Cllr Wright reported that she now has 3 volunteers and a meeting will be arranged very soon.

### 22/79 To Receive Reports (if any) from Parish Councillors

Cllr Turner has obtained arrows for the Public Footpath from the Crown Inn to Roselath and will attach them to posts on the route. More of the path has been cleared.

Cllr Wright said that the repaired signpost at Pennant Chapel was now in place and looking very smart.

Cllr Challis stated that tyres had been dumped near Gunwen and he will report these.

Cllr Haley reported that Cllr Hemmings and Robin have tidied around the plaque and seat in the playing field and will arrange for the gate closure issues to be fixed. Parents at the school are looking at options for new play equipment.

We believe that such a system should only be implemented if the people of Cornwall support it. We call on Cornwall Council and our local Cornwall Councillors to ensure that there is a referendum of all voters in Cornwall on whether to introduce this significant change, as set out in the relevant legislation.' Cllr Sinkins agreed to email Cornwall Cllr Linda Taylor to this effect.
